

# Invitation to Arctic Alta ski & fatbike festival 25th - 2 February 6th

Tverrelvdalen IL has the pleasure of inviting you to a tripon Saturday 2 February 2023. and fatbikeritt Sunday 26. February 2023. We organized the competitions together with Troms and Finnmark corporate sports circle in 2020, and alone with good help from volunteers in Tverrelvdalen IL and the surrounding area in 2022. The trail is partly new from last year, has been improved this year and is being prepared by a grooming machine all the way. We want to facilitate a safe event and encourage you to show consideration both in traffic and with regard to infection control. Our goal is to create a nice exercise event for Troms and Finnmark with high female and youth participation and in addition get several of the companies in Alta on the ski relay.

Youth class is up to and including 16 years old. The relay is mix class. 42 and 20 km have both trim and competition class. 12 km trim class only . Regular class classification according to NSF rules, but no special class award by age, except for youth classes.

#### <u>Awards</u>

- Everyone receives a participation prize with a coffee mug with Arctic Alta and a TIL logo on it.
- Gift check for top 3 women/men on 42km fatbike and skis
- Premier top 3 in 20 km both days, plus youth class
- Premier top 3 in the ski relay
- Sp urtpris (after 10km) and climbing price (after 22km) on 42 km fatbike / ski with 500kr for first woman / men.
- Award ceremony in the gymnasium at Kaiskuru Community Centre (café) after the finish both days.

### <u>Prices</u>

- NOK 450 for 42 km (recreational and competition)
- NOK 300 for 20 km competition
- 150 kr for 20 km trim
- 100 kr for 12 km trim
- 1200 for relay teams

For those who do not have a license, this is additional. From 13-25, a license costs NOK 60. From 26 years and up, a one-time license costs NOK 150 for competition and NOK 60 for trim. This is insurance in the event of an accident. Registration open until February 10th, post-registration (double price) possible to <u>arcticaltasport@gmail.com</u> Trimclass has the possibility of registration until the race starts on Sunday.

### Starting number delivery

Picked up at the BUL house in Bossekop Friday 18-19 Lørdag at 9-1 1 Sunday from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.

A start of 20 km can be picked up at the starting area in Detsika on Saturday from 11am-12pm and Sunday from 1am 0am-11pm .

For starters of 12 km on Saturday, you pick up a start pass between 10-13 at Ungdomshuset which you fill in and deliver at the finish Kaiskuru Ski Stadium

### Café and changing rooms/ wc

There will be shower facilities and a café at kaiskuru community centre. Toilet at BUL-huset at start 42km /relay, at start 12 km at Ungdomshuset and at the finish all distances at Kaiskuru community center.

## Transport between start and finish

There will be organized a bus transport for participants on Saturday from finish Kaiskuru to start in Bossekop(start 42km) and Detsika(start 20km) That runs from 9.am to Bossekop first, and then from Bossekop at 10 am and to Detsika. The bus is only at Saturday for the ski race, and is free of charge.

It is possible to take regular bus from the finish in Kaiskuru and back to the city center and Bossekop. Buses run every hour from 12.33 until the evening. Only a few minutes to walk from finish to stop and from disembarking Bossekop back to the starting area.
